ORDER MADE THIS 15th DAY OF SEPTEMBER, 2023.

Before the Honourable Justice N. Bardai in Chambers the 7th day of July, 2023.

ON THE APPLICATION of Gordon J. Kuski, K.C. and Amanda M. Quayle, K.C. (lawyers on behalf of the defendant/applicant, Mile Two Church Inc.) and on the Application of James S. Ehmann, K.C. (lawyer on behalf of the defendant/applicant, John Thuringer), and hearing Grant J. Scharfstein, K.C. (lawyer for the plaintiffs/respondents), Randall T. Klein, K.C. (lawyer for Tracey Johnson), Scott R. Spencer (lawyer for Aaron Benneweis and Deidre Benneweis), Brent D. Little (lawyer for Nathan Schultz) and Jaren G. Biden (lawyer for the Government of

Saskatchewan), and on reading the materials filed by the parties and the pleadings and proceedings had and taken herein;

THE COURT ORDERS:

1. The defendants are not required to file their defences prior to certification;
2. All defendants shall have until no later than October 31, 2023 to serve any and all requests for particulars on the plaintiffs;
3. The plaintiffs shall have until December 31, 2023 to serve all responses to requests for particulars on all defendants;
4. All defendants shall have until February 28, 2023 to serve any and all applications for better and further particulars on the plaintiffs, including all supporting materials;
5. The plaintiffs shall have until April 28, 2024 to serve the defendants with any material they intend to rely upon for the hearing of any applications for better and further particulars;
6. The Local Registrar shall schedule a call with the parties and Justice Bardai in March 2024 for further case management and for the purposes of fixing a date to hear applications for better particulars or setting a timeline for the conduct of the certification application;
7. The plaintiffs shall pay to the defendant, John Thuringer, costs in the amount of \$500, but not payable forthwith;
8. The plaintiffs shall pay to the defendant, Tracey Johnson, costs in the amount of \$300, but not payable forthwith; and

9. The costs of the defendants' application to delay the filing of defences shall be in the cause.
