Remedy claimed or sought:

- The Applicant/Defendant, Joel Hall ("Hall") applies for the following relief:
 - a. An Order pursuant to Rule 3-71 of *The King's Bench Rules* requiring the Respondents/Plaintiffs, Caitlin Erickson, Jennifer Soucy (Beaudry), and Stefanie Hutchinson (together, the "Plaintiffs"), to provide further and better responses to certain particulars requested by Hall in his Request for Particulars dated October 31, 2023 ("Hall Request") that are identified in Schedule "A" to this Notice of Application within 60 days of the date of the Order; and
 - b. An Order granting Hall the costs of this application.

Grounds for making this application:

- 2. Hall delivered the Hall Request pursuant to the September 15, 2023 Order of the Honourable Justice N. Bardai (the "September 15 Order"). The Hall Request concerns the Second Amended Statement of Claim dated June 29, 2023 (the "Claim").
- 3. In response to the Hall Request, the Plaintiffs delivered a Reply to Request for Particulars dated December 28, 2023 (the "Reply to Hall").
- 4. The Reply to Hall is deficient. Accordingly, Hall seeks an Order directing the Plaintiffs to provide him with further and better particulars to certain requests for particulars identified in **Schedule "A"** to this Notice of Application.
- 5. Hall is entitled to know the case against him. A key function of a statement of claim is to alert defendants to the case they are required to meet. The Claim does not alert Hall to the case that he must meet. Further, the Reply to Hall does not provide Hall with particulars that he requires to understand the case against him.
- 6. Hall is also entitled to particulars pertaining to the suitability of the within Action as a class action. In this regard, Hall is entitled to particulars that inform the certification criteria set out in s. 6(1) of *The Class Actions Act*, SS 2001, c C-12.01.
