
[1] On October 24, 2022, I designated Justice Bardai to consider the within class action certification application. Justice Bardai has now been appointed to the Court of Appeal and it is therefore necessary to designate a different judge to take over from him. I hereby designate Justice Wempe to consider the class action certification application in place of Justice Bardai.

[2] By fiat dated March 18, 2024, Justice Bardai issued the following directions:

I direct the Registrar to consult with the parties with a view to setting

three days for these [17] applications to be heard after April 2024. ...

[3] The local registrar should continue to consult with the parties and Justice Wempe to select the three days necessary to hear the outstanding applications.
